SHORTEN and IRV NOVICK's The Shield, and JOE SIMON and JACK KIRBY's Captain America. 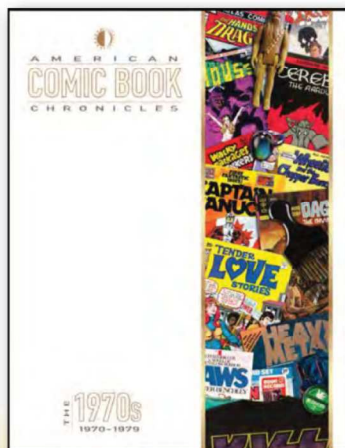
